Coda: "The music for Lent sounds like a dirge." If you work in church music long enough you hear some derivation of this. What most people are commenting on is the fact that most music for Lent is written in a minor key as opposed to a major key. But why choose minor? Key signatures are thought to have certain emotional characteristics. For example the key of D major was called "the key of glory" in the baroque era. That's why the Hallelujah chorus is written in D major. Lent is a time of reflection, fasting, and prayer. The scripture readings for Lent reflect this call to repentance and prayer and by extension the hymns do as well. So in setting a hymn text for Lent a composer or arranger will often pick a minor key to reflect the text. After all, would "Were you there" have the same impact if we were to sing it to an upbeat major tune?


