> The Light in the Church Strength in Numbers

There was a nobleman who wanted to build a church building where he lived. It was truly a masterpiece, and the people loved it. When they went inside, however, it was quite dark. They asked the nobleman where the lamps were. He explained that he had installed brackets in the wall that would hold the lamps. Then he gave a lamp to each family to bring with them each time they came to worship.

"Each time you are here," he said, "the place where you are seated will be lighted. Each time you are not here, your place will be dark. When you fail to come, some part of God's house will be dark." In the same way, when you are not here for worship there is a part of God's kingdom that is missing. There are many places in our sanctuary "not lit" on Sunday mornings because those who promised to support the church with their prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness are not here. Since the church is people instead of a building, the body of Christ is not complete without you.

Two rabbits were being chased through the woods by a pack of ferocious foxes. The rabbits dove into a hole. One rabbit cried out, "What will we do?" The other rabbit replied calmly, "We'll just stay in this hole until we outnumber them!"

Sometimes I hear people comment about why they don't belong to a church or why they don't come to church. One of the reasons mentioned most is that they believe that they can worship God better by themselves. They say that all the other people are just too distracting. They say that when people get together, there are tensions and conflicts.

These people do have a point. The church does have problems. We are not perfect. Anytime you get people together there are going to be problems. However, in this fallen world we live in, there are just too many problems, difficulties, and dangers to face alone. We need each other for strength and support. Otherwise, we are far too easily overwhelmed and defeated. I have found that in the church and with Christ in our midst, we easily outnumber our problems.

This is an exciting time to be a member of First United Methodist Church. The church is not the building. As the children's song says, "I am the church. You are the church. We are the church together." The body of Christ is not complete without you. So this Sunday, bring your lamp and let's light up the church! Let's build the body of Christ together.

"Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another...and all the more as you see the Day approaching." Hebrews 10:25 (NIV)




