

HUGE ADOPTION HAPPENING IN BRENHAM, TEXAS!!!!!

That's right, there is an adoption going on, and it is right here at FUMC, Brenham. Our church is pairing up with Blinn College this year for an exciting, first time ever event. We will adopt the 33 young ladies at Spencer Hall at the Blinn campus for the 2013-14 schoolyear. The administration there was thrilled at the idea and very supportive. They are hoping other churches and organizations will do the same.

Our church will have interaction with these young ladies every month in some way and we'll start out in August with helping them move into the dorm. Move in day is <u>Saturday</u>, <u>August 24th</u>, <u>10am-5pm</u>. We need about 5-6 strong guys who are willing to help carry in boxes and are able to climb a flight of stairs while doing this. You don't have to be there all day, just a few hours each would be great. They need dollies to use in moving. We'll also set up a table outside under a canopy and hand out ice cold water to students, parents, workers. We're making door signs with their names on them and a decorative item for each of their desks.

Other plans for the year include: something for football season, asking church members to buy extra tickets to the annual turkey dinner and donating them to the girls, sending cards to them on their birthdays and Thanksgiving, and making snacks for them before finals in December and May. Also, plans are in the making for doing something special at Valentine's Day and around Easter. So there are lots of things we can do to show the students we care for them.

We're inviting the young ladies to come to church any time they would like and will provide transportation here when needed. We're also looking into starting a short Bible study at their dorm.

We're looking forward to a great year with these girls, so please start praying now for the success of this ministry, for each young lady to have a great educational experience while here in Brenham, and that each of them will truly feel the love and presence of God during this coming year by being associated with our church.
