It was only a year ago that Pastor T.J. and I drove to Brenham from East Texas to meet with the Staff-Parish Relations Committee and staff. We were excited then and remain excited to be in ministry with this congregation in this beautiful community.

We had a terrific time at the church picnic on May 19th at Fireman's Park. We lost count of the number of people who attended but our best estimate was 150 plus children. The Pit Master team of Brad Bogan, Aaron Campbell, David Chisholm, and Tom Hook brought mouth-watering brisket, pork roast, jalepeno sausages, and smoked chicken. Thank you! Of course, no one ever can compare to the cooks we have in our congregation so the sides were great as well. The various ministry teams helped with everything from transporting the supplies to cleaning up. We all worked together and a good time was had by all. Thank you so much, everyone!

Sunday morning was cause for giving thanks as we baptized Milo Childs, confirmed ten young people (Conner Appelt, Addie Bogan, Abbey Cross, Milo Childs, Cass Seeber, Gunner Gee, Ben and Grant Rogas, and Callie and Caraline Ross) and welcomed the family of one of our confirmands into membership of our church. Thanks to all the parents, extended family and confirmation mentors for making the day so special.

There are people in our immediate community and beyond who listen to the live broadcast of our 11:00 **KWHI-AM 1280.** We have members of our own congregation and others who listen on Sunday mornings because they are no longer able to safely travel to church. Others listen because they are working or traveling, still others listen on an occasional basis. We recently welcomed someone into membership, Viv, who is a lifelong United Methodist and first became acquainted with this congregation through the live broadcast. It is particularly encouraging to me, however, to think of the unknown numbers of people who tune in to hear the music, prayers, creeds, Scripture readings, and messages about the grace of Jesus Christ that we don't even know about. For all of those, I pray for the blessing of the Holy Spirit.






