





The Woodcutter's Parable

"Come to me.... Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me."

Matthew 11:28-29

Once there lived an old woodcutter who decided the time had come to teach his son to follow in the woodcutting trade. The apprentice was young and eager, and each day would follow his father into the woods, swinging his axe with great zeal and vigor. However, as the days wore on, it seemed to the young man that the trees became tougher and harder to cut down. Progress slowed to a crawl.

Finally, when felling the trees became impossible, the young man turned to his father and cried, "Father, for some reason I am no longer able to cut down the trees! What is wrong with me?" The woodcutter saw his son's plight and answered, "Why don't you sit down, take a little time and sharpen your axe?" "Oh, no!" responded the boy. "If I do, I will never have the time to cut all these trees!" "Well," replied his father, "then I suppose that is a decision we all must make, whether to keep swinging at the trees, or take the time to sit and sharpen our axes."

Many Christians believe in the Lord, but finally feel they don't have the time to sit down and learn the Bible. They are too busy living. What they don't realize is, learning the Bible IS living! Such knowledge enhances our lives and makes living more fulfilling and more fun.

An Indian proverb says, "If you give a man a fish, he has only one meal. But if you teach him how to fish, he can live all his life." That is what Bible study is all about. I want us to be people grounded personally in scripture, not people who must rely on what others say about the Bible. To learn the scriptures takes time. But how could your time possibly be spent in any way better than this?

If you are tired of swinging at the trees and want to sharpen your axe, please pray about coming to our up-coming Bible study beginning Monday, September 15th at 10:00 a.m. We will be studying <u>Making Sense of the Bible</u> by Adam Hamilton. The six session study is divided into two parts. The first section addresses some foundational questions: how and when the Bible was written, the various types of writings found in it, and how and why some books made it into the Bible and some were left out. The second section digs into troubling questions and issues, such as historical accuracy, violence, and end times.

You will need to read the first seven chapters before our first meeting. Books are \$15 and available at the church office.
