#### A Message from the Pastors

The season of Lent begins on February 17 - Ash Wednesday. There are 40 days in Lent, mirroring Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness being tempted by satan. These were the 40 days of preparation for the beginning of his ministry. The number 40 must have been an important number in Judeo/Christian history. Remember that the Israelites wandered for 40 years in the wilderness before they entered the Promised Land.

Lent began as a time of preparation for converts to Christianity. Easter was the traditional time of baptism for the early church. Persons who were going to be confirmed would go through a period of prayer and fasting in preparation for their entry into Christianity. This time of preparation evolved into a season that all Christians observed – a time to prepare for the observance and remembering of the crucifixion, death and resurrection of Christ.

The time of preparation for baptism in the early church could not be done alone. The community became involved in helping faith to grow and mature. Candidates for baptism often spent time in peoples' homes, learning from the experience of daily life what was meant by discipleship. The entire congregation was involved in prayer for those who were led by the Spirit in this journey.

Still today we are called to learn and pray together; to have our lives shaped through the community of faith and fellowship. Lenten lunches, House Church, special times of worship and Sunday School provide many opportunities for each of us to prepare well to hear again the stories of God's redeeming love.
