A Word from the Pastors

Are you still singing the songs of Easter Sunday? Go ahead and shout Alleluia! The Easter celebration has just begun. Eastertide begins with the Easter vigil and ends with Pentecost. This year Pentecost Sunday is May 23.

In America we are accustomed to one-day celebrations. Each year in late November we begin a count-down to Christmas and begin putting away the decorations on December 26. But Christmas goes another 12 days! And then comes Lent – a time of fasting and prayer – a time to prepare for the sorrow of the crucifixion and the unbelievable joy of the resurrection. We rejoice in the news that Jesus lives – and then quickly go back to our 'normal lives.'

The ancient church spent this time reflecting on what had happened to them, experiencing this new life given through the waters of baptism, with the laying on of hands and the anointing, the renunciation and profession of faith. They called it mystagogy – exploring the mysteries of being joined to Christ and his mission through the sacraments. Another translation of mystagogy is 'savoring the mysteries.' These 50 days may again be used to focus all members of the church not only on the energizing force of the Easter experience but on the sustaining force of Christ throughout life.

You are invited to inhabit fully the wonder and grace of Easter. Experience the beauty of God's new creation. Embrace this new life given to you through Christ.

Let's keep this party going!




J.O.Y. LUNCH BUNCH


With Much Appreciation
