

Cost this year is \$210.





93 Year-Old Church Prepares for Move

93 years might seem like a long time, but for one church in Brazos County, it's just another milestone. The Methodist Church of Millican dates back to 1842. At that time Millican was the largest community north of Houston and Galveston. The present-day wooden structure was built in 1917 and houses the only church bell left in the community. The church has grown over the last decade and is now expanding into a new location. Millican UMC will be moved to a five acre tract of land that was given by Tommy and Ann Lyons. An activity center will be added and, later, a new sanctuary will be built.

After 17 days in the hospital, we were coming back to Brenham. I was thinking how great it was to be out. I told Michele, it must be like getting out of prison.

We have men in our church that are confined to their homes. They are homebound or in a Nursing Home for medical or other reason. Something that would really lift their spirits would be visits from some of the men in our church.

You don't have to come to United Methodist Men meeting to help with the shut-in's, all you need is about an hour each month to volunteer. Many of the elderly just want and need someone to talk to. When I was doing UMARMY, we found that many of the clients need work on their homes, but a lot of them just wanted someone to talk to.

Presently, we have a need for six men to visit with members at their home. If you can give an hour or so a month, please let me or Pastor Terry know.
